Road Department Report – Jim Erwin read the monthly Road Report submitted by Road Foreman, Frank Behan

Chief Shipman thanked the public for slowing down and driving more cautiously during the winter, there were a lot less accidents this past winter than last year.

 Motion was made by Mark Cline to hire <u>Thomas Lineman</u> as a full-time Garbage Crew Laborer with the effective date of March 22, 2021; at the starting rate of \$17.50

 Motion was made to advertise to receive sealed bids for the 2021-2022 Road Material; bids will be opened and awarded at the April meeting.

 Motion was made by Mark Cline to accept the Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of Bradford, Foster Township and Bradford Township police departments to the terms and conditions for rendering mutual aid and assistance as written.

Chairman, Jim Erwin discussed with the Board Members the concerns of the sewer line issues on Ann Lane; stated the lines are very old and for the past several years the lines are backing up; there is approx. 200 ft of sewer lines that needs to be replaced and or repaired and the township workers could do the work since it wouldn't cost too much for the repairs.

Motion made by Mark Cline to repair or replace the sewer lines on Ann Lane; work to be done by Township workers as a road / sewer project.

Motion made by Mark Cline, seconded by Steve Mascho Vote: Mark C.: Yes; Steve M.: Yes; Jim E.: Yes

Jim stated the sewer machine was used to check out the sewer lines on Ann Lane; the sewer machine did not work and had to call Foster Township and use their machine; will have Ken Swanson look over the sewer machine and see what's wrong and if repairs are needed.

Jim Erwin discussed purchasing a street sweeper with the Board members; he stated the current 1994 street sweeper was able to be somewhat repaired, however it's still not working properly. He suggested purchasing another used street sweeper since we only use it for about a month each year. Supervisor Steve Mascho stated to just keep fixing the one the Township has since it still works. Jim stated to Steve, it doesn't work properly and there are no parts available for it anymore if it breaks again. Supervisor Mark Cline stated the Township should purchase another used one that works properly and stop wasting money to fix an older machine that keeps breaking down.

Motion was made by Mark Cline to purchase a used street sweeper up to \$50,000.00, Second by Jim Erwin.
